Glenn grew up in Chesapeake, VA. After high school Glenn joined the Air Force. He was an Airman (E2) and served as a nuclear weapons specialist in Turkey, as well as in Vietnam, 90 miles from the DMZ line.

After the military Glenn worked for the City of Chesapeake as a Traffic Operation Supervisor for 36 years.

In 2003 Glenn and Susan moved to Palm Coast and became involved in SOTC. They joined the choir and both continue to sing. Glenn's passion for carpentry and his wood working talent is on display all around SOTC. In 2005, when our new church was built, Glenn fashioned the new Baptismal Font, which has fold down steps for older children. He also built the wall in front of the choir area. Glenn made the wooden boxes for LWML mites, Operation Barnabas Coupons, and Mission 1-1-1. He designed and built the mission bins in the narthex and the signs outside the Operation Barnabas door. He also rebuilt the original cross on the Fellowship Hall building.

He spearheaded the design and continues the maintenance for the memorial brick walkway by the chapel. Glenn has served as an Elder and as SOTC Congregational President. He also was the leader of Operation Barnabas for a while.
